It's got up to 70dB of gain so it's a nice choice for old ribbon mics and the expander works in such a natural way that, if tweaked properly, you can basically gate the self-noise right out of a mic circuit without chatter or unnatural decay characteristic.

Also, the top of this unit could be used as a hot plate for eggs ' hash browns. Even with the ventilation holes in the top, depending on what was racked above it, I might want more than 1U rack space above. It could probably heat a small apartment in the winter.
