A couple of years ago, just after the dot.com bust, I was able to purchase an Equitech balanced power conditioner for very little on eBay. It does a completely effective job or removing hum, noise, etc. and also has built

in surge suppression. I wouldn't have ventured \$1K+ to find that out, but for \$300 I took the chance. Highly recommended. If you watch the whole show it's obvious that it is not lip sync'd. The performances are too raw for one thing. A lot of mistakes with mic technique where the audio and video agree, etc. Obvious nerves showing through in the performances. Compressors being nailed way too hard on occasion. A lot of things pointing to a live performance.
